

REQUIREMENTS

- ♦ **SPIRITUAL** – Applicants must be able to articulate a personal relationship with Jesus Christ as evidenced by reflecting godly character as they seek to live daily for Christ. It is desirable for the applicant to have participated in a local church for at least six months. It is also desirable that the applicant be free from drug use, tobacco use, or alcohol abuse for at least six months prior to enrolling.
- ♦ **ACADEMIC** – Applicants from Canada and the U.S. must have completed high school (Grade 12 or GED) (transcripts required); International Applicants should submit all transcripts from any higher educational institute attended.
- ♦ **AGE** – The published minimum entrance requirements are 19 years of age prior to the start of the study period or graduation from grade 12 or equivalent.
- ♦ **FEE** – Applicants must submit a non-refundable Application Fee (see the blue Financial Information form).

AFTER YOU APPLY: The Registrar will evaluate your application once all forms, references, transcripts, and application fees have been received. You will be notified by the Registrar of the status of your application.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE FOR CANADIAN AND U.S. APPLICANTS**COMPLETE AND SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING:**

❶ **FORM A – APPLICATION** (4 pages) along with:

- The non-refundable application fee (\$50 CAD).
- A passport style photo attached to page 3.
- Official high school and/or college transcripts.

❷ **FORM B – PASTOR'S REFERENCE.** If your pastor is your parent or spouse, ask another pastor or member of the church staff to complete this form. FORM B must be sent to us by the referee and not the applicant.

❸ **FORM C – CHARACTER REFERENCE.** FORM C should be completed by a high school or college teacher, an employer or Christian friend over 21 year of age. FORM C must be sent to us by the referee and not the applicant.

❹ **FORM D – HOUSING APPLICATION.** Only fill out Form D if you are applying to be a CFN Bible College student, and are requesting to live in college housing. Residential living features apartments located in the city of Langley, BC, a short distance from the campus. The accommodations feature independent living, which allows students to prepare meals of their choice on their own schedule. The college does not have a cafeteria. CFN residential housing costs are kept to a minimum which can be a great advantage for the student as we live in an area where rental costs are very expensive. Specific costs are explained on the *Tuition and Fees* form. Because housing is limited, you are strongly encouraged to submit your housing application, along with the \$200.00 *Reservation Fee* as soon as possible. If the applicant is accepted for housing, this fee will be applied toward the housing costs. If the applicant is not accepted for housing, the fee will be returned. If the applicant is accepted for housing, but after acceptance chooses not to use college housing, the *Reservation Fee* is non-refundable.

Important note: If you desire housing, the last day to submit your reservation fee is July 15 for the Fall term and November 15 for the Spring term. If the *Reservation Fee* arrives after these dates, the price you pay for housing costs may reflect market value.

❺ **FORM E – REQUEST FOR TRANSFER CREDIT.** Only fill out Form E if you are requesting transfer credits to CFN that you have received from another institution.

U.S. APPLICANTS must obtain a Study Permit from Immigration Canada before entering Canada. You will need your your Letter of Acceptance, proof of identity (passport), and proof of financial support. See www.cic.gc.ca for specific details.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE FOR INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS

An international applicant shall be defined as a person who is not a permanent resident in Canada or the United States. There are no deadlines, however, we strongly recommend that an application should be made 8 to 12 months prior to the beginning date of the term in which you wish to enrol to allow time for the applicant to apply for and receive a study permit from Canada Immigration. Under no circumstances should you leave for Canada until: (1) you have received confirmation from Christ For The Nations that you have been admitted, and (2) you have obtained your study permit from Canada Immigration. It is not possible to change from visitor to student status within Canada - you have to leave the country to do this. **It is strongly recommended that you consider all issues concerning language, finances, and study permit requirements before you proceed.**

COMPLETE AND SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING:

STEP ONE APPLICATION

❶ **FORM A – APPLICATION** (4 pages) along with:

- A passport style photo attached to page 3.
- An official transcript of high school equivalent of Canadian grade twelve and/or college academic record.
- Application must be accompanied by an application fee of \$450 in Canadian funds, of which \$350 will be credited towards your account upon arrival and enrolment.

❷ **FORM B – PASTOR’S REFERENCE.** If your pastor is your parent or spouse, ask another pastor or member of the church staff to complete this form. FORM B should be sent to us by the referee and not the applicant.

❸ **FORM C – CHARACTER REFERENCE.** FORM C should be completed by a high school or college teacher, an employer or adult Christian friend. FORM C should be sent to us by the referee and not the applicant.

❹ **FORM D – HOUSING APPLICATION.** Only fill out Form D if you are applying to be a CFN Bible College student, and are requesting to live in college housing. Further information can be found on page one of this document.

STEP TWO LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ In order to be accepted in any of CFN’s programs for credit described starting on page 19, an international student, whose first language is not English, must have a **TOEFL** score of at least 550 Paper-based, 213 Computer-based, or 80 Internet-based. For further information on getting a TOEFL score contact: TOEFL Educational Testing Service, Box 899, Princeton, New Jersey, USA 08540 or www.toefl.org
 - Testing should be done in your country of origin at least 2-6 months prior to your first semester at CFN.
 - Please indicate code “1410” on your TOEFL forms so that your score can be directly sent to CFN.
- ✓ International applicants whose first language is not English who do not have a **TOEFL** score, or have a TOEFL score of less than 550 Paper-based, 213 Computer-based, or 80 Internet-based may apply to one of the **International English Language Immersion Program options** described on page 36 of the Academic Catalogue. The International English Language Immersion Program is not formal ESL training, yet is specifically designed for applicants who have some competence in English and would like to study the Bible and practical ministry in an English-speaking environment. These courses are non-transferrable.

STEP THREE STUDY PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ International students planning to study in Canada for six months or longer should apply for a study permit at the nearest Canadian consulate at least 2-8 months prior to your first semester at CFN
 - ✓ For complete information on Study Permits, consult the website of Canada Immigration: www.cic.gc.ca
 - ✓ Upon acceptance, CFN will send you a **Letter of Acceptance**. This letter is required to obtain a Study Permit from Canada Immigration. This letter is only one of many documents necessary to obtain a Study Permit (see below).
 - ✓ Please apply at the Canadian Consulate in your country of residence. Approved students must maintain full-time status and understand that transferring to any other status or educational facility requires permission from CFN and the approval of Citizenship and Immigration Canada.
 - ✓ To obtain your Study Permit, the following documentation will be required (visit www.cic.gc.ca for detailed information):
 - Proof of Acceptance: Offer of admission to Christ For The Nations Bible College and information about the expected time to complete the program provided in the *Letter of Acceptance* you will receive from Christ For The Nations Bible College.
 - Proof of Identity: valid passport and passport photos (sized according to specifications).
 - Proof of Financial support: You may be required to bring financial documents to prove you have the necessary funds (bank statements, scholarship & bursary awards and/or pledges of support from other organizations/individuals). You may also have to prove that you have sufficient funds for return transportation for yourself and any family members who come with you to Canada.
 - Proof of medical information: in some cases, you may have to provide a medical clearance
 - Proof of security: In some cases you may have to provide a police check.
 - Currently, the Immigration Services Fee for a Study Permit is \$125 (Canadian Funds).
